We were awarded a \$3000 Professional Development Grant from the Division. We used that money, some money from Counseling Services, and some donations from University Police Department, the Vice President for Administration and Finance, Health Services, and the Student Union to sponsor a 1 1/2 day training on threat assessment. We brought Dr. John Nicoletti to campus to train approximately 40 front line staff and faculty from across the division and from other divisions for one full day and 12 administrators on the half-day. Dr. Nicoletti is the author of Violence Goes to College and a nationally recognized expert on the subject of violence on college campuses. As a result of this training and increased awareness of these issues due to national events, the President's staff has decided to create a group of administrators, headed by the Vice President for Student Affairs, to serve as a place for gathering information about students of concern, assess the information, and develop a plan for intervention if necessary.
